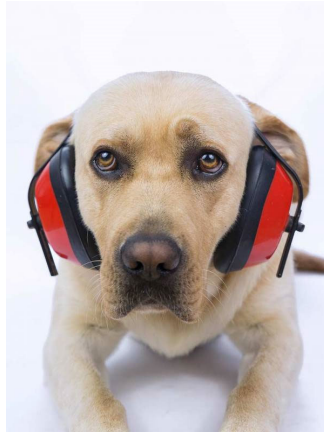


Keeping Pets Safe During Fireworks

Make a special effort to provide your pet somewhere to hide and make sure to have extra bedding to help them feel snug and secure.

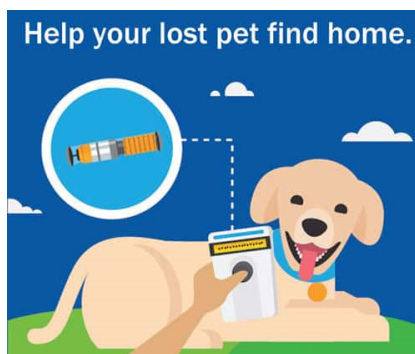
Drown Out the Noise
