

Working Dog Declaration

(Form Number: L-REGFRM012)

Dog Control Act 2000

Interpretation

Working dog means a dog used principally for –

- (a) droving or tending livestock; or
- (b) detecting illegal substances; or
- (c) searching, tracking or rescuing; or
- (d) working with police officers.

Penalty for false statement

A person who makes a false statement in a Statutory Declaration is guilty of a crime (*Criminal Code Act 1924 s113*) and can be fined, given a jail term or both.

For these penalties, the person making the statement would have to know that the statement was false at the time it was made.
