The General Manager cannot consider issuing of the licence until 28 days after the notice is published.

- I. All dogs over 6 months of age must be registered and micro chipped for a licence to be issued.
- II. You do not necessarily have to own all the dogs. If all the dogs are kept on one property, then a licence is required.
- III. A Kennel Licence may be issued with conditions and is for a set number of dogs.
- IV. Council reserves the right to cancel a Kennel Licence for failure to comply with the conditions attached or if it is in public interest. Four weeks notice will be given.
- V. Licences are required to be renewed annually. The Renewal is not required to be advertised; however, a variation to the number or breed of dogs may need to be.
- VI. A kennel licence is not transferrable to another property.
