Australia Day Awards

The Latrobe Council Australia Day Awards recognise the achievements of community members and groups who have made a significant contribution to the community of the Latrobe Council area.

You can nominate someone whom you consider outstanding in the categories of Citizen of the Year, Young Citizen of the Year and Community Event of the Year.

Eligibility

To be eligible for recognition, nominated individuals must have lived in the Latrobe municipality for a minimum of two (2) years.

Nominees must be Australian citizens and should have made a noteworthy contribution during the current year and/or given outstanding service to the community of the Latrobe Council area over several years.

- Nominees for Citizen of the Year Award must be older than 30 years on 26 January next.
- Nominees for Young Citizen of the Year Award must be between 14 to 30 years of age or younger on 26 January next.
- Nominees for Community Event of the Year Award must have been conducted within the Latrobe Council area this current calendar year.

Criteria

Nominees are assessed regarding their contribution to the community of the Latrobe Council area, significant or outstanding achievements, excellence of service, relevant background information and membership in community groups / sporting organisations / other bodies.

A submission of up to 500 words, addressing the criteria and accompanied by background materials that may be relevant, should accompany the nomination form.

Selection Process

Nominations must be received no later than 1 December annually. Once nominations have closed, the selection panel will consider all nominations and select the recipient in each category.

Nominees agree to allow the use of their nomination information for publicity purposes and to make themselves available, without cost, for publicity purposes as required prior to and after the Awards Presentation.

Award winners will be announced at Latrobe Council's Australia Day Awards and Citizenship Ceremony from 10:00 am on 26 January.
